MASA Camp Scholarship Program Description

Program: Dave Phillips and Al Harding are the members of the MASA Speed Skating Education Committee. The MASA calendar year starts July 1st of each year and ends on June 30th of the following year. The application form for the Camp Scholarship program will be posted on the MASA web site along with this Program description document and an e-mail letter will be sent to all MASA members by July 15th before most camps start for that season.

Program Rules Summary:

- To be called “MASA Camp Scholarship Program”
- Administered by a two or three person Speed Skating Education Committee if possible (two minimum); committee members and their children are not eligible to receive scholarships
- MASA will allocate funding based on the number of approved “Camp Scholarships” for each skating season; the plan and allocated money will be reviewed each year at the annual meeting in April and the plan approved/modified for the following season.
- MASA will offer MASA skaters in good standing, classes Pony through Senior (9 - 29), \$100.00 each toward the cost of an approved speed skating camp (approved by the Education Committee)
- A skater may get this assistance one time per season
- Only two members of a given family can receive scholarships in a season
- Payment
 - Check will be provided by MASA Treasurer to the skater or parent once approved by the committee. Funds will be returned to the MASA Treasurer if the skater does not attend the camp.
- Selection criteria based on the priority below:
 - MASA Camps have 1st priority
 - Completeness of Application
 - Neatness of Application
 - Quality of “learn” statements
 - Who applied first
 - MASA Speed Skating Education Committee has the final determination
