## MEMBER OF U.S. SPEEDSKATING (USS) CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1 Any non-consensual or un-welcomed physical contact, obscene language or gesture, implied threats or other threatening language made by a participant, Association member or spectator directed towards any Club member, Association member, Board member, official or spectator in connection with a Club and/or Association speedskating practice or competition may result in the denial or revocation of Club and/or Association membership based on the discretion of Board of Directors.
- 2 Any improper or serious disturbance, obstruction or disruption of the functions of Association Speedskating practice or competition by a participant, spectator or Association member which infringes upon the rights, orderly conduct or well-being of others may result in the denial or revocation of Club and/or Association membership and privileges based on the discretion of the Board of Directors.
- 3 The Club and/or Association reserves the right to refuse membership to individuals with a known history of non-compliance or acts of detriment.
- 4 Once the determination of membership revocation or denial has been made, notification of revocation or denial will be sent to all clubs within the jurisdiction of the Association.
- 5 USS shall be notified immediately of revocation or denial of Club and/or Association membership.
- 6 All Skaters, coaches, guest coaches and guest skaters MUST wear proper safety equipment including helmet, neckguard, gloves and kneepads.
  - I hereby agree that violation of this Code of Conduct may result in my immediate expulsion from a speedskating practice and the revocation of my Club and/or Association membership.
